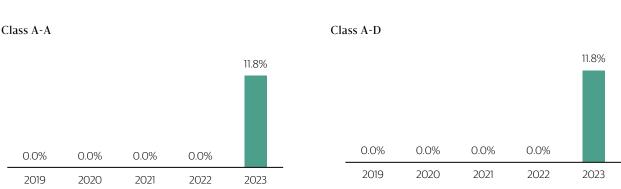
Past Performance of Full Calendar Years

These charts show the performance of Class I-A, Class I-D, Class A-A and Class A-D of ECRED as the percentage loss or gain per year over the last year. ECRED's first full calendar year of actual past performance data starts in 2023 and past performance data is therefore shown as from that year. Past performance does not predict future returns. Markets could develop very differently in the future. It can help you to assess how ECRED has been managed in the past.

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Performance Scenarios(1)

Where performance acquisitions reveals a stress reparation the process reparation the stress reparation will be adjusted to match the unfavourable scenario.

Where performance calculations reveal a stress scenario to be more favourable than the unfavourable scenario, the stress scenario will be adjusted to match the unfavourable scenario. In accordance with regulatory requirements, performance scenario figures reported in monetary terms are rounded to the nearest 10 euro (or equivalent currency), and performance scenario indicators in percentages to one decimal place.
